
Apartment Tour: An Artistic Penthouse at Marina One Residences




The penthouse is split into two large wings—a private corner for the bedrooms, and various


public areas for socialising. Located at the far end of the living area is an open-concept dry


kitchen as well as an ebony marble-top dining table that seats a party of 10. The dark brown

and white palette allows for more extravagant details to shine through—above the dining table


hangs a chandelier with fine strands of beads cascading downwards.









